Community Arts Day

Come join us downtown on Fri, March 5 and Sat, March 6 for the First Annual Community Arts Day. The celebration of the arts will kick-off on Friday evening with the Opening Reception for the Northwest Artist's League and George Kosinski exhibit at the Wilkes Art Gallery from 6:00pm to 8:00pm. Gallery 315 will hold an Opening Reception for the (RED) exhibit during the same hours. Both events will be free and open to the public.

On Saturday, the Wilkes County Public Library will feature creative dramatics with the Wilkes Playmakers, an art exhibit from local youth artists provided by the Wilkes Art Gallery and Wilkes Smart Start, live music performances by members of the Wilkes County Acoustic Folk Society and Family Storytelling by tellers including Ken Welborn and Maria Parker.

The Wilkes Art Gallery will provide clay demonstrations and Face Jug Making workshops for both children and adults. The Gallery will also offer a free collage and stamping workshop. Dance performances and musical performances by the Wilkes Acoustic Folk Society will also be featured, as will an artist talk by exhibiting artists. All events will be free.

The culmination of the event will be the creation of a Community Art Project. The Wilkes Central Art Department will create a RASP (Recycling Awareness Sculpture Project) with the assistance from members of our community. Participants from the ages of 2 to 102 are encouraged to visit the Gallery's education center, observe the creation of the sculpture and actually participate in its creation. You are encouraged to bring recyclables to add to the project.
