## Annual Fireworks Planned

## Facade Grant Addition and NEW Mural Grant

The Historic Downtown North Wilkesboro Design Committee met the challenge for 2007-2008 year to revise the Facade grant. The application has been simplified with the addition of notes referencing Design Guidelines of specifications and regulations. As well as simplifying the process, the Committee also added a landscaping portion to the grant. Business and Building owners can now apply for a landscaping grant within the facade grant program. A description, scaled drawing and maintenance plan must be submitted with the application and are subject to approval by the Design Committee and the HDTNW Board of Directors.

An exciting new program was created by the Design Committee to assist in the restoration of historic ghost signs and other mural artwork for the downtown. The new mural grant will require a separate application from the facade grant. Details of the project, an artist rendering of the mural, and a maintenance plan must be submitted with the mural grant application. In addition to approval by the Design Committee and the HDTNW Board of Directors, the mural grant will also be approved by the Town Commissioners.

The architectural quality of North Wilkesboro's downtown area is important to the entire town, its history, image and economy. The appearance of downtown is largely determined by the condition of its buildings.

Because this appearance also forms the basis of the public's overall impression of downtown, the upgrading and preservation of North Wilkesboro's downtown is crucial to the continued livelihood of North Wilkesboro. Historic Downtown North Wilkesboro, Inc. (HDTNW) and the Town of North Wilkesboro would like to encourage all downtown property owners to participate in this program.
